A. Position Summary

Reports to the Product Manager and deals with various functions of processing titanium billet and bloom products working in the forged products business unit. This position acts as a liaison between processes, customers and production.

B. Job Duties / Responsibilities

- Responsible for dealing with the day-to-day aspects of processing titanium billet and bloom products.
- Assure current process routings conform to customer specifications.
- Review, edit and approve daily sales and shop floor production orders.
- Develop cutting instructions for the shop floor in order to meet order requirements.
- Develop and revise existing routings for new customer orders based on new inquiries.
- Analyze new inquiries and advise costs for quoting; assisting in the development of accurate process cost evaluations by working with the accounting department.
- Work with customers on new orders and issues including: conference calls, new orders, existing orders, problem resolution, etc.
- Develop and implement techniques for improved process control, yields, costs and through put.
- Analyze data, problem solving and making recommendations for process improvement.
- Applying the metallurgical fundamentals of processing parameters to achieve dimensional, macro and micro structural, and mechanical property characteristics of titanium billet and bloom.
